• For more information about being a vendor and getting a booth, call Annie at 525-8602. Regarding entertainment, contact Dan Clark, 522-0399. (Los dos hablan español.)

• Pioneer Park is located at the corner of Alder and Division streets in Walla Walla; approximately half a mile east of downtown.

• Do not delay in applying for your booth or you may not get a spot. In the past we have **sold out.** Vendors whose applications are post-marked **before May 25** will get mentioned in our promotional materials and advertising. Or, applications received after June 1 must pay a **\$5 late fee.** FINAL DEADLINE (FOR ALL BOOTHS): Sunday, June 12 (1 week before event).

• If you would like *confirmation* that your application was received and accepted, please send a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your application.

• Full refunds are available if you cancel at least 2 weeks before the event, otherwise you'll get a 50 percent refund. No refunds will be given within 48 hours of the event.

• You will get your booth assignment between 8 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Sunday, June 20. Look for Annie and her red flag in the half-circle on the east side of the bandstand at Pioneer Park.

•You must be set up and have your personal vehicles removed from the festival area by 11 a.m. (You can temporarily park on the grass behind your booth while unloading.) **NO PARKING** in the circular road that goes through the park; it is a fire lane.

• HEALTH DEPT. INFO: All food vendors *must* contact the health department at 524-2662 AT LEAST TWO WEEKS IN ADVANCE regarding food handler's cards and food service permits. (If you have a permit for the Farmer's Market you still need another permit for Diversity Day.) Each food booth needs at least one person with a food handler's card (two are recommended). Baked goods may have different rules; call and ask. Hazardous food (such as meat, eggs, beans) require more expensive food service permits. The health department will make inspections the day of the event (but will not issue permits.) BE PREPARED. PLAN AHEAD.

• If your booth distributes disposable items (paper plates, cups, etc.) you **must** provide your own **trash cans**. You may also provide seating and tables. We suggest that instead of using disposable food containers, you use edible, reusable or recyclable containers. (Recycling bins will be available for bottles and aluminum cans.)

• Remember to bring your own L-O-N-G extension cords and water hoses, if necessary. Also, you are responsible for your own tables, tarps, chairs, etc.

• Religious literature should be appropriate to the festival's theme of diversity, respect & inclusion. **No** proselytizing.

• It is highly recommended that you provide your own *liability insurance*. Our insurance does not cover individual vendors.

## WAIVER AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT
